BALL OUT 3X3

DISQUALIFICATION PROCESS

The event provides referees to ensure that the game is played to the rules of 3x3. In the event that a player disregards the rules and the referee feels that the player is dangerous to themselves or others, is disrespectful to themselves or others, or is bringing the reputation of the event into disrepute, it is at the discretion of the referee to make the decision to disqualify a player.

In extreme circumstances, a member of the core team can request a player be removed from the playing area to maintain the standard of play and/or behaviour required for the event.

If a player is disqualified from a game, the player must leave the playing area and can take no further part in the competition. This would include a player being disqualified in a qualifying event. The disqualified player would not be able to re-join their team in the Final's day event should their team have qualified for the finals.

Referees decisions will be supported by the events Core Team.

Should a disqualification occur, a member of the Core Team needs to be notified immediately - as soon as is appropriate - by a runner and/or table official. The Core Team will record the disqualified players name and ensure that they take no further part in the event.

This will be explained to the player and/or their team by the Core Team.

The event in no way can condone bad behaviour. It will take a lot to receive a disqualification!

Ball Out 3x3 will maintain a record of players that have been disqualified at its events. Should a team and/or player receive more than 3 disqualifications, they will receive a ban for one year.
